FCO SHINGLE STREET

The breach in the sea wall north of Shingle Street was reported on the morning after the surge on 5/6th December to Coast Guard and EA.

They organised for Contractors to view the breach that afternoon.

Work to build up the breach started on Wednesday 11th Dec., between 300 to 400 tons of clay from a source near Colchester was in place by Saturday lunchtime. Final profiling remains to be completed, in hand at this moment, then top soiling of the wall and re-profiling the shingle river bank. Not bad going. About 75 acres of land flooded.
