

OVERVIEW & PHOTOS

As with earlier reports on this section, the prime concern is the state of the top. With the increasing loss of any grass cover and an ever increasing footfall, the surface, including along the trial section, is turning to mud in wet weather with the obvious associated damage.

The dips referred to in earlier reports are becoming more extensive.
