As with all FC4.2 reports, the key concern is the continuing deterioration of the top surface. In the dry weather preceding the survey, cracks had opened up in the exposed areas of mud as shown in the photographs below.

The netting has lifted creating a significant trip risk as shown on the photograph. It is not clear who is responsible for repair of this section (between the sewage outlet and stile).
