The potential impact of Sizewell C on the Alde and Ore estuary area is a major issue for members and that is why we have set up our first Zoom meeting to hear more about the potential impact. EDF are poised to start the application process for the Development Consent Order to start construction in 2022 but we and many others have protested that proper consultation cannot begin until after the Covid 19 restrictions have been lifted.

The Association raised key issues in March 2019, given our dynamic and fragile coastline and the immense disruption to the area over the ten years the construction will take place (see [www.aldeandore.org](http://www.aldeandore.org)). There are still no answers to these questions.

We are still in lockdown but matters may move fast should the DCO submission go ahead now. This experimental Zoom meeting will provide an opportunity for members to hear more from Stop Sizewell C and ask questions

***Please note:** the Association so far has only challenged aspects of the Sizewell C plans that need to be fully explored to avoid damaging the area should the plans go ahead. It has remained neutral on the issue of the energy policy which is outside its remit.*
